




If you had to choose only one option, which Union should, in your opinion, Ukraine join in the future?




What, in your opinion, is the biggest obstacle for Ukraine to become a member of the European Union?



If Ukraine would become a member of the European Union, in your opinion, what advantages would it gain in this case?




What might be the negative consequences of Ukraine's accession to the EU?




24% of Ukrainians already have a new biometric foreign passport




Do you plan to travel to EU countries in the next year?




If you are planning to go to EU countries, then what will be the purpose of your visit?




By what type of transport do you plan to travel to EU countries?




Do you consider yourself a European?

Nationwide polling of the Ukrainian population was conducted by the Ilko Kucheriv Democratic Initiatives Foundation and the Kyiv International Institute of Sociology from August 16-28 with the support of the project “Civic Synergy”, which is funded by the European Union and implemented by the International Renaissance Foundation.

A total of 241 respondents aged 18 and older were polled in all regions of Ukraine (in 110 settlements), with the exception of the Crimean Autonomous Republic and the occupied territories in the Luhansk and Donetsk oblasts. The theoretical margin of error was 2.3%.
